A dash of history

Visit the Clabber Girl Museum for an inside look at a baking legend

It's hard to imagine a kitchen in America without a jar of Clabber Girl baking powder in the cupboard. The company, which is located in downtown Terre Haute, has been in the business for more than 150 years. From its roots as a wholesale grocery store under the Hulman & Co. name, Clabber Girl eventually began making its own products — including baking powder.

Today, the company makes baking soda, cornstarch, and other foodservice items. Groups can visit the Clabber Girl Museum for a look at the history of one of America's oldest companies.

Tempt your taste buds

The Clabber Girl Museum offers guided group tours that can be supplemented with a choice of packages. Museum exhibits include historical examples of the company's brands, as well as a Clabber Girl delivery wagon. Group members can also see antique household items.

Guided tours are free for groups of 6–25 people; a small per-person fee is charged for groups of 26 or more.

The Coffee Break package combines the guided museum tour with a visit to the Bake Shop. The menu features items that have been made from scratch.

The Better Baking Basics package includes a guided museum tour and a coupon to the Country Store or Bake Shop. Antonia's Country Store sells items for home cooks, including the complete line of Clabber Girl products. This package also includes a cooking demonstration and taste testing with a variety of options.

The Daily Culinary Delights package includes the museum tour, breakfast or lunch served by the Bake Shop, a Country Store coupon, and a variety of culinary demonstrations. As part of the Simple Sensations package, groups can combine a cooking demonstration, museum tour, and Country Store coupon with a plated lunch.

The Delicious Dishes package offers everything available in the Simple Sensations package, except group members will be served a plated dinner instead of lunch.

Group tours should be scheduled at least three weeks in advance; payment is due two weeks before the scheduled tour.
